

Person County 4-H Clover Cash Policy

Person County 4-H Program

Clover Cash—Financial credit given to a young person for their participation in the Person County 4-H program. Once a 4-Her earns Clover Cash for the first time, an account will be created and maintained to recognize participation and achievement of that 4-Her.

Earning Clover Cash—Clover Cash may be awarded for activities as deemed necessary by the 4-H staff to encourage participation in programs that meet the overall objectives of 4-H youth development. These may include but are not limited to the following: 4-H Project Record Books, Cumulative Records, 4-H Presentations, content specific programs (i.e. horse, shooting sports, livestock, etc.), other programs that warrant the use of scholarships to reward participation. A detailed list of activities and events with the amount earned is included at the end of this document. This list will be reviewed annually by the 4-H Advisory Board and revised as needed.

Use of Clover Cash—Clover Cash may be used for county, district, or state 4-H workshops, retreats, camps, curriculum, or 4-H Catalog purchases. Clover Cash is NOT actual cash money.

Record of Clover Cash—Each 4-Her who earns Clover Cash will have an account recorded in a Clover Cash Notebook and will be kept in the office of 4-H Agent. Account activity will be recorded in this notebook once Clover Cash has been awarded or used. 4-Hers can contact the 4-H Agent to inquire about their balance.

Reversion of Clover Cash—If a young person leaves the 4-H program, the unused balance will be reverted to the Person County 4-H account. If a 4-Her has not had any activity in their Clover Cash account in 2 years, or has aged out of 4-H, funds will be reverted back to the Person County 4-H account.

Transfer of Clover Cash—Clover Cash is generally not transferrable between 4-H members. In the case of siblings, one may transfer to the other with the specific written consent of the one relinquishing the funds.
